

HALL OF FAME CLASS OF 2022 CHRIS CORBITT SERGEANT TALLAHASSEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

Christopher Corbitt is a Sergeant with the Tallahassee Police Department in Tallahassee, FL. His law enforcement career began in 1992 after graduating from the Lively Technical Law Enforcement Academy (currently known as the Florida Public Safety Institute) and becoming a reserve Deputy Sherriff with the Wakulla County Sheriff's Office. He joined the Tallahassee Police Department in 1995 and has been assigned as a patrol officer, field training officer, criminal investigator,

adjunct firearms instructor, adjunct internal affairs investigator and technical operations investigator. He was promoted to Sergeant in 2012 and supervises the Department's Technical Operations Unit. Sergeant Corbitt has received several Department awards including the Command's and Chief's award of excellence, meritorious service, productivity, unit citations, and humanitarian response. He is a Certified Technical Investigator with the National Technical Investigators Association (NATIA) and currently serves as the Vice President of the Southeast Chapter of NATIA. As a NATIA member, he provides training to others on a variety of law enforcement related technologies.

Sergeant Corbitt developed an expertise in telecommunication devices and communication record analysis through work on hundreds of criminal investigations. He provides expert witness testimony in numerous trials and conducts training for law enforcement officers, prosecutors and analysts nationwide. Throughout his tenure in the Technical Operation Unit, Sergeant Corbitt has worked to bridge current and emerging technologies with the Department's mission of protecting and enhancing the quality of life for Tallahassee's citizens.
