J. Timothy Moore

James T. "Tim" Moore was the longest serving Commissioner in the history of the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE), from 1988 to 2003, having served under three Governors. His total length of service with FDLE was over 30 years. During his tenure as Commissioner, Moore led the agency during many statewide challenges, criminal justice enhancements and significant growth of one of the most respected criminal justice agencies in Florida and the nation. The fundamental values that he brought to FDLE—Service, Integrity, Respect & Quality—are still the key guiding principles of FDLE.

While Commissioner Moore served on numerous national and state

boards and commissions, including his selection by Governor Jeb Bush to lead Florida's Domestic Security efforts in the aftermath of the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001. He also served on the U.S. Department of Homeland Security Advisory Council and was appointed by President Bush to the President's Homeland Security Advisory Commission. Moore was also a member of the National Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, and the Executive Committee of the International Association of Chiefs of Police for over 12 years. He was also actively involved in the Florida Sheriffs Association and Florida Police Chiefs Association.

Under his leadership, FDLE experienced remarkable growth—more than doubling the agency's total budget and staffing allocations. Additionally, Moore's tenure saw significant growth and improvements in facilities including a new headquarters in Tallahassee and new Regional Operations Centers and Crime Laboratories statewide. All this growth resulted in enhanced service to local law enforcement and the people of Florida.

Moore was also actively involved in the leadership development and delivery of disaster related response, recovery and preparedness initiatives in Florida.

Moore was inducted into the Florida Law Enforcement Hall of Fame in 2017.

Currently, Moore serves as a Senior Partner with *The Integrity Group* and is actively involved in the company's delivery of services in the area of Disaster Recovery Consulting, School Safety and Capital Assurance Professionals (corporate and governmental compliance services).
