SUBJECT: Academic Curriculum Changes

Item Description

This item presents a new program and course proposal revisions and an updated lab fee request. This item also presents the Workforce Education Current and Projected Facility Needs list.

Overview and Background

The Academic Planning Committee members review and make recommendations for Board approval for new and revised curricula.

The College proposes the Patient Care Technician program. This new program allows students to obtain employment in the healthcare industry, filling critical roles as nursing assistants, phlebotomists, medical assistants, and personal care aides. These positions are listed on Florida Commerce's Fastest Growing Occupations List.

The College also proposes several program changes and course revisions. These changes are proposed based on state mandates, accrediting agencies, and modifying curriculum based on advisory board suggestions. One change includes the proposal for two new mathematics state core courses that will align with Florida's Mathematics Pathways.

Additionally, the College is proposing the updated Workforce Education Current and Projected Facility Needs list. This list contains new and continuing programs along with a localized need assessment that will be included in the College's educational plant survey. Approval of the list is the first step in the process of developing the educational plant survey.
