Course Description:

This 16-hour ASHI course will provide a simple, practical program to help develop or refine basic life support knowledge, skills, and the confidence to respond to a life-threatening emergency and when it is possible, to save or restore life. Instructor students will learn the legal aspects of CPR, evaluate and ensure instructor students have good teaching knowledge of CPR skills, and how to effectively teach the skills to students attending the CPR class.

Explain the legal aspects of rendering emergency medical treatment

Demonstrate treating an obstructed airway in adults and children

Demonstrate different methods of cardiopulmonary resuscitation

Demonstrate two-person cardiopulmonary resuscitation

Demonstrate one-person CPR

Choose the proper method for applying CPR or treatment of the obstructed airway in the conscious and unconscious adult, child, and infant

Identify the consequences of performing CPR incorrectly

Identify considerations for moving victims
