

Team Control and Vehicle Extractions Region XV

Course Description:

This law enforcement-based Team Control course focuses on how two or more officers can work together to control and ultimately arrest a resistant subject. Team handcuffing techniques and takedowns will be covered as well as weapon entanglements with one or more officers are present. Additionally, vehicle extractions techniques for single and multi-officer response to resistant occupants will be covered.

Training will occur both with and without duty gear to show how the gear helps and hinder these techniques. Officers who complete this course will be granted access to email and phone support for future questions about defensive tactics and team-tactics related questions.

Equipment:

- BDU/Tactical pants along with duty belt and/or external vest to include handcuffs.
- Training (blue) gun. NO LIVE AMMO OR WEAPONS ALLOWED
- Wrestling shoes or smooth soled shoes are allowed on the mats. No boots!
